DARJEELING

Region: Gopaldhara Estate, Darjeeling, India

Grown in the foothills of the Himalayas this black tea has notes of muscatel, mandarin, ginger and wood spice.



JASMINE

Region: Fu Ding, Fujian, China

Scented with Jasmine blossom, this green tea has a delicate floral aroma and notes of apple sherbet, lychee and vanilla.



HOJICHA

Region: Tenryu, Shizuoka, Japan

Made by roasting second flush Sencha green tea, creating rich umami flavour and deep aroma. With notes of hazelnut, seaweed and roasted chestnut.



OSMANTHUS

Region: Jinxi Tea Estate, Putian, Fujian

This lightly oxidised tea is scented with fresh osmanthus flowers, apricot, custard apple and mountain cucumber with honey floral notes.
